Bindings

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You take in your skis regularly for service to have the edges tuned and indulge in a wax job. But what about your ski touring bindings? Take a look here at our tips on proper care for your DYNAFIT bindings.

NICE TO KNOW

- ▶ The release value of your bindings can change from dirt, incorrect storage, or if you store your skis for a longer period. Meaning before the start of a new ski touring season, but also from time to time, you should have the release values checked by an authorized dealer.
- ▶ Our bindings feature impressive high quality and a long lifespan. Every model is made by hand in Germany.

CLEANING

- ▶ Your bindings should be cleaned when dirty to maintain their performance and function.
- ▶ To clean your DYNAFIT bindings, use a cloth and lukewarm sudsy water.
- ▶ Acidic or other harsh cleaning agents or artificial cleansers should never be used. They can damage the bindings' materials and compromise their function.

CARE

- ▶ Check your bindings regularly yourself to discover any rust spots, cracks, or deformation early.
- ▶ Have your bindings checked by an authorized dealer before the start of a season or as needed and have the settings checked.
- ▶ Your bindings' settings not only depend on the type of bindings and boots but also on the type of skier you are.
- ▶ Inserts in your ski touring boots with great wear-and-tear can also lead to compromising the release of your bindings.
- ▶ Repairs and adjustments should only be performed by an authorized professional dealer!



TRANSPORT

- ▶ Best is to transport your skis with the bindings inside your automobile or in a roof cargo box in a ski bag.
- ▶ During transportation on a ski rack on your roof, your skis and bindings can be exposed to salt and dirt that can compromise the binding's performance and function.

STORAGE

- ▶ Storing your bindings and skis in a frost-free, dry room is especially important. A space with great temperature fluctuations is thus not well suited.
- ▶ Never store your skis near acid-absorbing items (such as chimneys or automobile batteries) or in a garage. Acidic exhaust can damage your skis as well as your bindings.
- ▶ Store your pin bindings with the least amount of tension as possible. Avoid keeping the springs under tension. To that end, close the toe pieces without locking them and set the heel units to ski mode.
